Capacity Listed (fire code) 300

Pews 27 @ 128" divided by 22" equals 157

- Note:
1. Seating numbers do not include balconies.
 2. Capacity Listed numbers are listed as maximum number of individuals permitted in whole structure not just worship area.
 3. Does not include space reserved for wheelchairs.
 4. Approximately 20 persons can be seated in the Saint Francis Solanus annex when additional space is needed.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Holy Cross has a balcony which is currently used for storage. It could be used for seating but the stairs are narrow and steep and raising the railing would be required. There is a large room behind the pipe organ (which is not currently played at Masses) that could be used for storage.
- St. Francis Solanus has a balcony which is used during the summer for Masses and for faith formation during the year. The church also has a “cry room.”
- St. James has a balcony which is used at weekend Masses and also a “cry room.”
