#### OTHER INFORMATION

- ➤ Holy Cross has a balcony which is currently used for storage. It could be used for seating but the stairs are narrow and steep and raising the railing would be required. There is a large room behind the pipe organ (which is not currently played at Masses) that could be used for storage.
- > St. Francis Solanus has a balcony which is used during the summer for Masses and for faith formation during the year. The church also has a "cry room."
- > St. James has a balcony which is used at weekend Masses and also a "cry room."
