## **Thanksgiving Ecumenical Service**

This service was well received. Four churches participated: Ovid Federated, Interlaken Reformed, The Episcopal Church of Willard, and Mary, Mother of Mercy. Ministers/pastors from each of these churches were present and participated by sharing a reading, psalm, story. The churches' music ministers took turns provided music. The service ended will a combined choir with members from all 4 churches singing "We Are Many Parts." After the service the Fellowship Committee provided a beautiful reception. There were 50-60 people present at the service/reception. Holy Cross will host this service again in 2020.

## **TACC Choir**

Parishioners of Mary, Mother of Mercy under the direction of David McLallen performed two pieces at the Trumansburg Area Churches Concert. They sang beautifully. Both pieces were arranged by David McLallen. Fr. Bernard has a CD of the concert. There were 8 churches who participated in this concert. ### **Christmas Vigil**

The parish will purchase 150 Lenten Magnificats (\$.90/each) for parishioners to pick up after the Ash Wednesday liturgies and to use throughout Lent. We are asking for a \$1 donation.

## **Day of Reconciliation**

This is a mandated event set by the diocese. This year it is scheduled for **Tuesday**, **March 28**, **2017.** Parishioners will have the opportunity to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation from **12pm-7pm at St. Francis Solanus**.

The LPC is planning a Reconciliation Service in addition to the Day of Reconciliation will take place on Monday, April 10 (Monday of Holy Week) at 7pm at St. Francis Solanus. This will be a prayer service involving music and readings. Parishioners will have the opportunity to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation.

## **Additional Lenten Services**

Stations of the Cross

Stations of the Cross will take place weekly on Thursday nights at St. Francis Solanus. There will be a soup dinner offered at 6pm followed by Stations of the Cross at 7pm and Benediction. We will need to find musicians. There should be music in between each station (when people are moving to the next station). It was suggested that we ask music ministers at each of the three churches to cover one week. This information will be distributed to music ministers at the next music ministers meeting on February 2, 2017.

#### **Music Ministers Meeting**
