Parish of Mary, Mother of Mercy Finance Notes for Parish Council March 10, 2022

The parish ended January with Net Revenue of \$34,425 compared to \$13,392 for the same period last year.

General Collections are \$124,427 which is up about \$7400 from the same time last year.

The only Capital expenditures that we have had so far this fiscal year are for the new shower at the St. James rectory and the new sewer line at St. James. These 2 projects totaled \$10,198.

The parish has total assets at the end of January of \$541,400.

Fr. Bernard's report:

The net operating revenue increase over last year is due in part to a \$10,000 gift to the parish. This fiscal year donations/gifts to the parish have amounted to \$14,460 as compared to last year \$1,910.

Regarding Non-Operating Revenue, the Diocese of Rochester gave the parish a grant of \$10,000 toward the cost (\$42,000) of the repair of the SJA parking lot and sidewalks.
