Word Committee Report

The Word Committee met on March 24 at SFS Parish Hall. About half of the meeting was discussing the questions for the Synod. The other half of the meeting was concerned with religious education for 2022-23.

The current situation is that we have only a few families participating in religious education. Our current coordinator, Susan Guydosh, has announced that she is stepping down. We looked at various ways to assist in educating the children for upcoming year, as well as ways it was done in the past. It was decided that since there were so few families involved, we would try to get individual 'tutors' for the children, that would visit the families in their homes and educate the students on topics taken from the USCCB guidelines.

We will try to bring the larger group together for various bigger topics, such as Christmas and Holy week for a group discussion about the birth of our Lord and the Passion, respectively. Susan had noted this was tried over the past year, but we did not get a good response to the group decisions. We would begin canvassing for volunteers in late June.

The Sacrament of Confirmation was held at Immaculate Conception on April 5th, with Bishop Salvatore Matano. MMM Parish had 4 students confirmed.

First Holy Communion will be held this Sunday, May 15, at St. James the Apostle Church. We have one communicant.

In other news:

The Easter Egg Hunt took place with light snow flurries falling on Easter Sunday at St. James. We had a good showing.

The Chair of the Word Committee respectfully suggests the June Parish Council Meeting be held at the St. Fidelis Friary Boathouse.

Regional Finance Director's report (Rebecca Pizzirusso)

The parish ended April with Net Revenue of \$2,987.19 compared to \$39,471.50 for the same period last year. The change is mostly due to the change in value of our investment accounts.

General Collections are \$168,274 which is up about \$2,000 from the same time last year.

Since our last meeting, the only Capital expenditure has been for asbestos removal in the boiler room at St. James. This project cost was \$5,500 bringing our total Capital expenditures for the fiscal year to \$15,693
