

Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception:

This year the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated tomorrow **Monday**, **December 9th**, together with the obligation for the faithful to attend Holy Mass.

9:00 a.m. at St. James the Apostle, Trumansburg
6:00 p.m. Mass at Holy Cross, Ovid

Following both Masses will be an opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Holy Cross Cemetery Cleanup:

Next Sunday, December 15, at 1:00 p.m., volunteers are needed for the fall clean-up at Holy Cross Cemetery. Tasks include removing empty flower pots, sticks, litter, etc. It's a large cemetery, so all is appreciated.

Advent Birthright Donations:

This Sunday and next Sunday, our parish is collecting donations for Birthright in Ithaca. Please place your donations of diapers, wipes, formula, toiletries, and new clothing in the basket to the side of the altar at St. James the Apostle, Trumansburg.

Adult Study:

Everyone desiring to know and discuss our faith are invited to attend classes on Saturdays (with one exception, the second Saturday of the month) at 5:00-6:15 p.m. at the St. Francis Solanus annex. These sessions are also helpful for people desiring to be received into the church and for Catholics preparing to celebrate Confirmation and First Communion. Cemetery Collection Next Weekend:

Next weekend is the second collection to benefit the Mary, Mother of Mercy parish cemeteries. The cemeteries do not generate regular income and do not have a fully funded Permanent Maintenance Fund. Please give what you are able as this collection helps to defray costly maintenance expenses. Donations may also be made online using WeShare Online Giving.

Please note that the monetary donation to the cemetery can be specified either for St. James the Apostle or the Holy Cross cemetery. When the monetary donation is not specified, your donation is divided between the two cemeteries. Thank you for your help.

Cemetery- Right to Burial Plot Cost:

The cost of buying a plot at both St. James the Apostle and Holy Cross cemeteries will be increasing as of January 1, 2025. A plot purchase provides you with the right for burial in either the traditional part of either cemetery or, at St. James, in the green section. Presently the price to purchase a traditional plot is \$700. On January 1 that will increase to \$900. To purchase a plot in the green section at St. James will increase from \$950 to \$1000. Eucharistic Revival–Invite One Back Initiative:

During September, October, and November, our parish has been praying for over 200 parishioners whose names have been submitted for prayer to return to the Lord in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Now is the time, the Season of Advent, the month of December, for parishioners, in a hospitable way, to personally invite a parishioner back to encounter Jesus in Holy Communion. You might encourage them to celebrate the Sacrament of Confession also to have the assurance of reconciliation, forgiveness, and union with God who throws our sins behind us never to be remembered. We Catholics today are more aware than ever that we must be missionaries – be invitational, like Jesus. "Invite one back."

Catholic Ministries Appeal:
