

Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025:

The Ordinary Jubilee Year - the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord - began in all the dioceses throughout the world on Sunday, December 29th. It will conclude on December 29, 2025. A Jubilee Year has been proclaimed every twenty-five years since the thirteenth century. The theme for this Jubilee Year is *"Pilgrims of Hope."*

"SouperBowl" Sunday—February 9:

SouperBowl Sunday is a national ecclesiastical event. By raising food and money, it draws attention to those experiencing the need for food in our communities. All food and funds raised in our parish will stay in the local food pantries in Interlaken, Ovid, and Trumansburg.

Non-perishable food and personal care items can be brought to our churches any time that you are able to do so. On February 9th, a basket will be in the back of the churches for any monetary donations that you might wish to make. 
